REHACARE from 14 to 17 September 2022 in Düsseldorf Comeback with many innovations and programme highlights for rehabilitation and care

Soon it's time: REHACARE will open its doors again in Düsseldorf after a two-year break! From Wednesday, 14 September to Saturday, 17 September 2022, companies from 38 countries will present their new products and services for rehabilitation and care in exhibition halls 4 to 7. The products on offer range from children's aids, mobility aids of all kinds, vehicles converted for the disabled (Hall 6) and tips on barrier-free travel (Hall 5) to exoskeletons (Hall 6) rehabilitation, prevention and therapy through sport (Hall 7A). In addition, self-help groups and associations will be on hand to provide the public with advice and information on current health policy aspects.

TREFFPUNKT REHACARE: Long COVID and many exciting highlights in the lecture programme

Parallel to the trade fair, the lecture programme at TREFFPUNKT REHACARE - the social, societal and political focal point of the trade fair - in Hall 6, Stand E25 offers a variety of exciting topics. For two years, our health system has been operating in a state of emergency. The pandemic is still pushing many areas of primary care to their limits and with the diagnosis of Long- or Post-COVID we are facing an additional challenge. REHACARE is the first trade fair to focus on the topic of Long-COVID and offers those affected a multidisciplinary platform for exchange with experts. On Friday, 16 September 2022 at 11:00 am., Barbara Steffens, Head of the NRW State Office of the Techniker Krankenkasse (TK) and former NRW Minister of Health, will open the series of lectures. Heiligendamm), Dr. Pantea Pape (Neurological Therapy Centre Cologne) and Dr. Mario Siebler (MEDICLIN Specialist Clinic Rhine/Ruhr) will provide information on the latest state of science. In addition, a variety of therapy options such as inpatient, outpatient or telemedical rehab, psychological care as well as complementary treatments such as pressure chamber therapy will be presented.

Digitalization of social work

The first lockdown in the wake of the pandemic has also changed social work with people in need of support. Entry bans, Covid measures and quarantine required new approaches and ways of working. Various model projects funded by the NRW Social Foundation will be presented at the NRW Welfare Foundation's Action Day on 14 September 2022 in Hall 6 at the NRW State Government stand. The entire projects will be scientifically accompanied by the Düsseldorf University of Applied Sciences. Interested parties will have the opportunity to get in touch with the contact persons at the stand during the course of the day and find out more about the digitalization of social work.



The interactive exchange with experts from politics, research and practice will also be the focus of the other specialist presentations with the following topics:

- Inclusion companies as an employment opportunity in the general labour market
- Job coaching in the workplace
- Digital projects such as the model project "Experience transformation - design digitalization to fit" of the NRW Welfare Foundation

- Innovations in the field of vocational rehabilitation and technical assistance

New at REHACARE: Exoskeleton Park

Ideas and solutions for redesigning the workplace will be presented in the "People with Disabilities and Work" theme park in Hall 6. New this year: the Exoskeleton Park. "Exoskeletons are already being used in industry to prevent back pain - now the focus is on whether and how they can be used in occupational rehabilitation", reports Dr. Urs Schneider, Head of the Human-Technology Interaction Department at the Fraunhofer Institute for Manufacturing Engineering and Automation (IPA) in Stuttgart, who is playing a key role in organising the Exoskeleton Park at REHACARE. He will also talk about the challenges and opportunities in the field of rehabilitation and technical assistance at the REHACARE Forum on Wednesday, 14 September at 1:00 pm. Anyone who would like to try out how exoskeletons can provide relief at the workplace for the back, hand or other parts of the body can do so, since participation, touching and trying out are definitely encouraged at REHACARE.
